

Spelling Practice Activities

Dear Parents,

Here are some great ways to practice the spelling words!

- www.spellingcity.com (attached is a paper with the teacher's name. The password is coalcity)
- Delicious Words-Write the words with your fingers on a tray of shaving cream or peanut butter.
- Spell words with magnetic letters on cookie sheets.
- Spell words with alphabet macaroni or alphabet cereal.
- Use watercolors to write the spelling words.
- Write sentences using the spelling words.
- Spell the words using alphabet stamps.
- Use clay or play dough to make the spelling words.
- Write the words 3-5 times each.
- Make flashcards for the spelling words.
- Write rainbow spelling words. Make each letter a different color.
- Write the words using crayons. Make each consonant blue and each vowel red.
- Hop for each letter as you orally spell the words.
- Clap for each letter as you orally spell the words.
- Make a list of rhyming words for each spelling word.
- Write the words in the air.
- Cut out letters from magazines or newspapers to spell the words.
- Write the words in alphabetical order.
- Make a word search and find the spelling words.
- Take a written practice test.
- Take an oral practice test.
- Letter tiles to spell the words (attached)

- Write the words in a sentence.
- Wikki Sticks to spell out the words.
- Put the words in ABC order.
- Use whiteboards, chalkboards, or magna doodles.
- Picture words-draw a picture and write your words in the picture
- Story words-write a story using all your words
- Reverse Words write them in ABC order backwards
- Create an activity-Can you think of a fun way to do your spelling words?
- Telephone words- translate your words into numbers from a telephone.
- Popsicles-make words with popsicle sticks
- Secret agent words-number the alphabet 1-26, then convert each letter to a number code
